With a \$50 billion program ceiling and five-year base period with one three-year option beginning in July 2021, STARS III allows for long-term planning of large-scale program requirements and supports 8(a) small businesses.

Identification of a need – Federal Government has a need for service or supplies

02

Contracting Officer identifies SG Tech as a company that can receive the sole source contract. This may include meetings to assess capabilities and preliminary pricing

03

Contracting Officer contacts [s3@gsa.gov](mailto:s3@gsa.gov) to speak to a STARS III Business Development Specialist who will direct the Contracting Officer to any required training

04

Contracting Officer issues a Request for Proposal (RFP)

05

Contracting Officer and SG Tech negotiate the price for the scope of work contained in the RFP

06

Contracting Officer and SG Tech sign the sole source contract
